FACTS	WHAT DOES FREEDOM ACCEPTANCE CORP (FAC) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Under federal law, that means personally identifiable information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number • Account balances, payment history; transaction or loss history; credit history; employment
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons FAC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

WHAT WE DO	
How does FAC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards, secured files and buildings.
How does FAC collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • apply for a loan • give us your income • give us employment information • pay us by check • provide contact information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit some but not all sharing related to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • nonaffiliates to market to you <p>See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

DEFINITIONS	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>FAC does not share with our affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>FAC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>FAC does not jointly market.</i>

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION
<p>For Nevada residents only: We are providing you this notice under state law. You may be placed on our internal Do Not Call List by calling the telephone number in the <i>Questions</i> section.</p> <p>Vermont: Under Vermont law, we will not share information we collect about Vermont residents with companies outside of our corporate family, unless the law allows.</p> <p>California: Under California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of FAC, unless the law allows. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extent required by California law.</p>
